**2007 O'HARE SCHOOL COMMITTEE WORK PLAN**

## A) 2007 O'Hare School Noise Monitoring Report and Presentation

Mr. Frame reported that currently 4 schools are eligible for funding. He called on Jeffrey Jackson to give a brief presentation on how schools are monitored and the results of the testing.

Mr. Jackson provided a brief presentation on the process of school sound monitoring. He explained that previous monitoring requirements included 1) existing conditions, traffic patterns; 2) placed monitors windows open and closed; 3) record real time traffic; and 4) utilize ANMS to correlate radar data to noise measurements. He explained that currently schools are being monitored in correlation to the OMP Rod full build-out contour map using future conditions.

Mr. Jackson reviewed that monitoring results for 2007. He mentioned that over 100 schools have requested to participate in the program in the past and based on monitoring results conducted in 2007 4 schools currently qualify for sound insulation using the OMP full build-out contour map. The four schools that are eligible for sound insulation include the following:
