Watch O'Hare Airport Flight Patterns Aboard CDA Community Vehicle Aug. 2

Meet Aviation Experts at 'National Night Out' in Arlington Heights

Des Plaines, Ill., July 18, 2011—Watch simulated O'Hare Airport flight patterns on flat screen monitors in the Chicago Department of Aviation's Community Outreach Vehicle Tuesday, Aug. 2 from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m. during the Arlington Heights "National Night Out" special event at North School Park, Eastman Street at Arlington Heights Road.

Families are invited to visit the fully equipped CDA bus that holds special appeal for youngsters who can follow airline flight tracks over their neighborhoods.

CDA and O'Hare Noise Compatibility Commission representatives will talk one-on-one with visitors about the O'Hare Modernization Program's 2011 revised runway construction plans and sound insulation programs for schools and residences.

The vehicle also features light boards illustrating the OMP's wide-reaching relationship to communities surrounding the airport.

The CDA hybrid bus will appear along with police, fire and other agencies, demonstrations, bands, a business expo, games and anti-crime tips.

The "National Night Out" program involves citizens, law enforcement agencies, civic groups and local organizations in more than 15,000 communities to strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships.

ONCC, composed of representatives from 28 Cook and DuPage communities, Cook County, and 16 school districts, strives to reduce the impact of aircraft noise on surrounding neighborhoods of O'Hare International Airport through home and school insulation, and to reduce, wherever possible, aircraft noise at its source.
