PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – MAY 3, 2013 MEETING

Mr. Ryan moved and **Ms. Bernardi** seconded that the minutes of the May 3, 2013 ONCC meeting be approved. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.

SPECIAL PRESENTATION – Elgin-O’Hare Western Access (EOWA) Project Nashif Manar, Senior Project Engineer for the Illinois Tollway and Libby Braband, Public Involvement Lead for the EOWA Project.

Ms. Braband thanked ONCC for the invitation to review the EOWA project. She called on Mr. Manar to give a brief presentation on the progress of the project.

Mr. Nashif reviewed the funding status and travel benefits of the EOWA once the entire project is complete. Travel benefits include accommodating 3 times as many vehicles per day as local road traffic and reduces travel time by more than 7 minutes for the 11-mile trip between the west side of O’Hare Airport and U.S. Route 20/Lake Avenue. The extension of the Elgin O’Hare Expressway reduces travel times to Hamilton Lakes Business Park and will also provide new access to O’Hare Airport via York Road.

Mr. Manar reported that the project will create or sustain up to 36,000 jobs.

REPORT OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION – AMY MALICK, DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, CHICAGO DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION

April 2013 ANMS Report

Mr. Jeffrey Jackson reviewed the April 2013 Airport Noise Management System report that showed Runway 22L was the most-used departure runway at 39%; Runway 27L was the most-used arrival runway at 17%. Complaint calls totaled 1,863 from 802 complainants. A total of 2,285 operations were reported in April 2013. He said of the 802 complainants, 220 complaints were made during the nighttime hours for April 2013.

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION CHAIRPERSON – DR. RAYMOND J. KUPER

A. FAA Correspondence and ONCC Response to Neighborhood Communities

Dr. Kuper reported that correspondence from the FAA and ONCC response to neighborhood communities were located in the meeting packets for the ONCC members to review.

C. Proclamation Honoring William Hood, American Airlines

Dr. Kuper read the following statement about Mr. Bill Hood's legacy:

Bill Hood joined American Airlines in 1994 when anti-O'Hare sentiment was running very high in townships and villages surrounding the airport. A coalition had been formed to combat noise and pollution called the Suburban O'Hare Commission (SOC). By 1996, Mayor Daley realized that O'Hare needed to make and keep friends and invited suburban leaders to form another commission – the O'Hare Noise Compatibility Commission, made up of municipalities and school districts. Membership in SOC excluded members from joining ONCC. On behalf of American Airlines, Mr. Hood supported ONCC and was instrumental in gradually expanding the intergovernmental agency's membership. Between 1995 and 1999 American and United Airlines commissioned surveys of attitudes toward O'Hare Airport among residents in the airport's surrounding areas. The surveys found generally positive attitudes toward O'Hare. SOC's solution to the noise and pollution issue was to build a south suburban airport. It mounted that campaign by charging each municipality a per person fee to finance the effort. Chicago's answer was creation of ONCC, funded by both City of Chicago and federally available funds, to sound insulate schools and homes.

In 1999, the leaders of every major airline in the country signed a letter to the Illinois Governor stating that even if an airport were built in the south suburbs, none of them would fly there or contribute to its construction. Bill worked with the City of Chicago to pass legislation in 2001 to modernize O'Hare.

Dr. Kuper said that Bill's tenure at American has covered five Chicago Department of Aviation commissioners while he worked alongside Chairman Mulder and Dr. Kuper for all these years.

Dr. Kuper presented Mr. Hood with a proclamation and thanked him for all his years of service to the community.

Mr. Hood thanked the ONCC for all their support and efforts throughout the years.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

School Sound Insulation Committee Report – Dr. Raymond J. Kuper, School Sound Insulation Committee Chairperson

Dr. Kuper reported that Ridgewood High School celebrated their school sound insulation open house on June 5, 2013. He mentioned that there were many people in attendance at the open house and thanked all that were involved.

Dr. Lupo thanked the ONCC for all its efforts and those involved in the sound insulation process.

Dr. Kuper thanked Ms. Debra Parenti for being part of the ONCC and wished her well in her retirement.

Ms. Parenti thanked ONCC for all their efforts in having Elk Grove High school sound insulated.

ONCC Technical Committee Report – Mr. Joseph Annunzio, Technical Committee Chairperson

Mr. Annunzio reported that the ONCC Technical Committee met on May 14, 2013. He thanked Mr. Dennis Ryan for chairing the meeting, which lasted 2 hours. The committee reviewed Fly Quiet Reports for the 4th Quarter 2012 and 1st Quarter 2013 and an update to the Fly Quiet Manual. These documents can be retrieved from the ONCC website. The 2013 Nighttime Construction Awareness Program flyer was provided in the meeting packets. Nighttime construction may cause intermittent nightly closures on some preferential runways. The CDA updated its O'Hare Aircraft Noise Comparison Chart and

also provided the 2012 Terminal Area Forecast which showed that operations are expected to increase.

Mr. Annunzio reported that there is a meeting scheduled for June 19, 2013 with the Air Traffic Control Manager to discuss better adherence to the Fly Quiet Program.

The next Technical Committee meeting will be held on August 13, 2013.

Residential Sound Insulation Committee Report – Ms. Judith Dunne Bernardi, Residential Vice-Chairperson

Ms. Bernardi reported that homeowner briefings for Phase 16 were held in late 2012 and in January 2013. There are currently 1,016 homes signed up for the Phase 16 Program. Home inventories are complete on 99% of those homes. Bids for the construction work were opened in early February and are under review by the City's procurement department.

The FAA and the State Historical Preservation Office are reviewing the proposed sound insulation projects for the historical homes in Phase 16.

The next Residential Committee Meeting will be held May 15, 2013.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR – MS. JEANETTE CAMACHO
